(PHD) DEGREE - GRADING SYSTEM

I. Comprehensive doctoral examination

Method of evaluation - each member of the Examination Committee grades each subject from 0 to 5 points – an average should be counted afterwards.

Fulfillment of the examination - if the candidate should take exam on three subjects

1. subject (main)	at least the average of 2.00	doubles	exam average (the average of at least 3.00 for a successful examination)
2. subject (subsidiary)	at least the average of 2.00	counts once	
3. subject (subsidiary)	at least the average of 2.00	counts once	

Fulfilment of the examination - if the candidate should take exam on the main subject only (ie. she/he completed the PhD training programme within 3 years)

II. Defense of the dissertation

Method of evaluation: each member of the Committee of Assessors grades from 0 to 5 points. *Approval of the dissertation*

For a successful defense the candidate should be given at least 60 % of the maximum points (that is, the average of at least 3.00 points). The average of the points given by the members of the Committee is the *defense average*.

III. PhD degree - overall grading system

The PhD degree may have three overall grades on the basis of the defense's average and the average of the comprehensive doctoral exam.
