# **ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS**

English-language proficiency exams TOEFL iBT Score: 61+ or IELTS Score: 5.5+

AND

High school GPA: 3.0+ (based on a 4.0 scale)

# **CONDITIONAL ADMISSION**

OSU offers conditional admission to students who meet all admission requirements except the English language proficiency requirement.

Upon submission of scores meeting assured criteria and/or successful completion of 12 weeks of advanced English language training from an accredited English language institute, students will be fully admitted to OSU. Visit okla.st/conditional for more information.


