OVERVIEW

The Gateway Hungarian-Chinese Exchange Program is designed for undergraduate and graduate students from Chinese universities, offering a one-semester curriculum entirely in English. It introduces key areas of law, international relations, political science, and industrial relations, emphasizing European and global perspectives, with a focus on Hungarian experiences. Students improve their legal vocabulary and communication skills through practical legal English courses. Additionally, guest lectures officials, academics, by government experts and cover contemporary legal, economic, and political issues.

TUITION FEE: 3,300 USD (one-time, includes accommodation)

*ADDITIONAL COURSES: 450 USD (per each additional course)



ACCOMMODATION

The tuition fee includes accommodation in well-equipped individual apartments shared by 3 to 5 people, offering greater comfort and privacy compared to standard dormitories.

APPLICATION

ACADEMIC: At least two semesters in Law, International Studies, or Social Sciences.

ENGLISH: Minimum CET-4, IELTS 5.0, or TOEFL IBT 70 (preferred: FCE, IELTS 5+, TOEFL 59+).

APPLICATION: Submit a motivation letter (academic/career goals) essay; online interview may required.

HEALTH: General Health Certificate and health insurance required before departure.
