The Gateway Hungarian-Chinese Exchange Program is designed for undergraduate and graduate students from Chinese universities, offering a **one-semester curriculum entirely in English**. It introduces key areas of law, international relations, political science, and industrial relations, emphasizing European and global perspectives, with a focus on Hungarian experiences. Students improve their legal vocabulary and communication skills through practical legal English courses. Additionally, guest lectures by government officials, academics, and experts cover contemporary legal, economic, and political issues.

ACCOMMODATION

APPLICATION

ACADEMIC: At least two semesters in Law, International Studies, or Social Sciences.

ENGLISH: Minimum CET-4, IELTS 5.0, or TOEFL IBT 70 (preferred: FCE, IELTS 5+, TOEFL 59+).

APPLICATION: Submit a motivation letter (academic/career goals) and essay; online interview may be required.

HEALTH: General Health Certificate and health insurance required before departure.
