Kitonics János – Directio methodica and the "unexpected codification" of procedural law in the Hungarian Kingdom

Topics: Hungarian legal history is rich in examples of legal treatises that have obtained binding force through customary law and have thus become equal to "codifications" of law. One of the rather neglected examples is the fate of the work Directio methodica authored by Joannes Kithonich (János Kitonics), which was included in the official collection of Hungarian laws, Corpus Iuris Hungarici. The lecture first introduces the life and works of this author and his significance especially for the history of Hungarian procedural law. Furthermore, the main features of the work written by Kitonics will be introduced, besides presenting the actual principles and contents of the Directio methodica itself. Special attention will be paid to the ethical standards for lawyers and judges, which may still be perceived as relevant even nowadays.

Prof. JUDr. Tomáš Gábriš, PhD., LLM (born 1981) is a Full Professor at the Faculty of Law of the Trnava University in Trnava (Nagyszombat), Slovakia, and a researcher at the Slovak Academy of Sciences, Institute of State and Law in Bratislava (Pozsony). He focuses scholarly and pedagogically on the history of law and legal thinking, on the methodology of law, theory of law and legal philosophy. He is the author of thirteen scientific monographs, co-author of ten textbooks, and in total author of more than 300 publications.
