In the professional activities category, points may be awarded for professional activity connected to the undergraduate programs of the University of Szeged since students submit their applications at the Faculty of Law and Political Sciences. Outstanding achievement at other universities or in postgraduate and doctoral programs will not be taken into account during the evaluation process.

Published in a faculty/university journal/edited volume (regardless of the language) - 2 points

Scientific presentations:

Conference presentation in a language other than the applicant's native language, outside the Faculty - 4 points
Conference presentation in the applicant's native language, outside the Faculty - 3 points
Presentation at the Faculty in a language other than the applicant's native language - 3 points
Presentation at the Faculty in the applicant's native language - 2 points
Other academic presentation - 1 point
