APPLICATION

ADMISSION INTERVIEW

Since the program is fully taught in English, language skills will be assessed during the Admission Interview - conducted online or in-person. Applicants will be asked about their previous studies, research interests, and future plans.

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

A minimum **IELTS** score of **6.5** or an equivalent **TOEFL** score of **79-93**, corresponding to **CEFR** levels **B1-C2**.

OR

A previous degree completed entirely in English exempts an applicant from the above language requirements.

ELIGIBLE DEGREES

- International Relations (BA)
- International Studies (BA)
- **✓** Juris Doctor (JD)

Please note however, that other degrees may also be eligible:

Applicants without a previous degree in Law, International Relations or International Studies must submit their academic transcript for review by the Admission Committee to verify compliance with the required 30 ECTS entry credits, as per Hungarian regulations.

If accepted, such applicants must take up compensatory courses evenly distribtuted during the first academic year.
